## Residential Service Rate: (Rate 01, 03)\*

Rates apply to houses and apartments with one residence.

## General Service – Demand: (Rate 11, 12)\*

Rates apply to non-residential services using more than 100 kW during the summer months, or more than 25,000 kWh per month.

\$14.25 per kW primary *(\$13.30 in 2025)*

Facilities Charge

\$7.25 per kW secondary *(\$7.10 in 2025)*

\$5.25 per kW primary *(\$5.00 in 2025)*

**Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**

2.77¢ per kWh secondary

**Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**

## Heating Service: (Rate 21)\*

Rates apply to non-residential services with separately metered space heating and/or water heating.

\$475.00 large service *(\$422.00 in 2025)*

## Large Light and Power: (Rate 15, 16)\*

Rates apply to non-residential services using more than 400 kW but less than 20,000 kW during the summer months, or more than 100,000 kWh per month.

Customer Charge - \$450.00 per month *(\$400.00 in 2025)*

Demand Charge

\$17.75 per kW secondary *(\$17.70 in 2025)*

\$17.25 per kW primary *(\$17.00 in 2025)*

Facilities Charge

\$7.42 per kW secondary *(\$6.43 in 2025)*

\$5.90 per kW primary *(\$5.20 in 2025)*

Energy Charge

**Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**

2.55¢ per kWh secondary

2.42¢ per kWh primary

**Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**

2.45¢ per kWh secondary

# Customer service fees for 2026

Effective Jan. 1, 2026

*Proposed changes for 2026*

## New Service Fee

Applicable to every new account, move, transfer, etc., upon the request for service initiation (excluding accounts with a current Landlord Options form on file.) \$10

## Late Payment Fee

Applicable to all accounts for amounts not paid by the due date on or after the first business day past the due date. 3.0 Percent of Past Due Amount

## Disconnect Charge for Nonpayment

Applicable to delinquent accounts.

Disconnection reminder	\$10
Basic disconnection	\$65
Meter technician disconnection	\$115
LES crew disconnection	\$200

## After-Hours Reconnection Charge

Applicable when line crew reconnects service outside of normal workday business hours on an account that was disconnected due to delinquency. \$100

## Returned Payment Fee

Applicable to accounts when a customer's payment is returned to LES from a financial institution. \$15

## Inaccessible Meter Fee

Applicable when an attempt by LES to read, service or access a meter is unsuccessful. \$75

## Temporary Service Fee

Applicable when a temporary service and meter is required. \$200

## Meter Tampering Fee

Applicable each time LES discovers a tampered, bypassed or otherwise misused meter. \$315

## Customer Requested Outage Fee

A fee charged for switching functions to de-energize and re-energize LES facilities.

Customer requested switching rate for overnight hours (10:00 PM – 8:00 AM)	\$500
Customer requested switching rate for Sundays and Holidays:	\$700
