Lincoln Electric System offers a Large Power with Market Energy Rate to encourage and stimulate commercial and industrial business growth in and around Lincoln, Nebraska.

The rate is aimed to attract and serve very large customers who would like access to real-time pricing.

Availability

The rate is available to customers with a minimum monthly billing demand of 20 megawatts. Customers must take service at 115 kilovolts (transmission-level voltage) and must own and maintain their own substation.

How it works

- Participants will not have a facilities charge as the customer is not utilizing LES' distribution system.
- Customers pay 100% of generation and transmission costs to serve their load.
- LES will register the customer load as an asset owner in the Southwest Power Pool for the purposes of billing.
- The energy charge will be the aggregate of all customer-specific load-related charges assessed by the Southwest Power Pool.
