

# EV Charging

*Recharge and discover Lincoln*



- LES installed two electric vehicle charging stations in the city of Lincoln's Green 2 parking garage (530 P St.) during the fall of 2014.

Each ChargePoint station has two charging ports, three of which are for public use. The fourth port is reserved for DEC/LES vehicles.

- These public charging stations are the first in the City.
- The units are Level 2, 240 volt/30 amp chargers (7.2 kilowatts).
- There is a \$2 flat rate for a charge.
- Drivers are requested to limit their use to four hours.
- Data gathered from these stations will help LES gauge the demand for electric vehicle charging stations in Lincoln.



## Electric vehicle charging at an LES-sponsored station...

### *Easily start a four-hour session using:*

- Your ChargePoint card.
- The ChargePoint mobile app.
- A contactless credit card with an RFID chip.
- Or, by calling driver support at 1-888-758-4389. This number is listed on each ChargePoint station and on the back of every ChargePoint card.

### *Charging your electric vehicle:*

- After making your \$2 payment, press the handle button to remove the charging connector.
- Simply plug in.
- When you are all charged up, tap your card or call to end the session. You may also end a session using the ChargePoint mobile app.
- Unplug the connector and return it to the station.
