



# SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RETAIL ELECTRIC RATES FOR 2019

## Residential Service Rate: (Rate 01, 03)\*

Rates apply to houses and apartments with one residence.

- Customer Charge - \$5.00 per month
- Facilities Charge per month
  - \$18.00 Level 1 (*\$15.00 in 2018*)
  - \$26.00 Level 2 (*\$21.50 in 2018*)
  - \$40.00 Level 3 (*\$33.75 in 2018*)
  - \$45.00 three-phase
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 8.01¢ per kWh (*8.58¢ in 2018*)
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 5.48¢ per kWh (*5.86¢ in 2018*)

## General Service: (Rate 10, 13)\*

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Rates apply to non-residential customers using less than 100 kW during the summer months.

- Customer Charge - \$6.50 per month
- Facilities Charge per month
  - \$16.60 single-phase
  - \$51.50 three-phase
  - \$28.50 primary
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 9.08¢ per kWh secondary
  - 8.80¢ per kWh primary
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 6.06¢ per kWh secondary
  - 5.85¢ per kWh primary

## General Service – Demand: (Rate 11, 12)\*

*No proposed changes for 2019*

Rates apply to non-residential services using more than 100 kW during the summer months, or more than 25,000 kWh per month.

- Customer Charge - \$25.00 per month
- Demand Charge
  - \$10.95 per kW secondary
  - \$10.75 per kW primary
- Facilities Charge
  - \$3.95 per kW secondary
  - \$2.90 per kW primary
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 3.40¢ per kWh secondary
  - 3.25¢ per kWh primary
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 2.57¢ per kWh secondary
  - 2.40¢ per kWh primary

## Heating Service: (Rate 21)\*

Rates apply to non-residential services with separately metered space heating and/or water heating.

- Customer Charge - \$5.30 per month
- Facilities Charge per month
  - \$32.45 single-phase (*\$25.20 in 2018*)
  - \$129.70 three-phase (*\$96.70 in 2018*)
  - \$269.70 large service (*\$238.70 in 2018*)
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 8.05¢ per kWh (*8.31¢ in 2018*)
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 4.93¢ per kWh (*5.04¢ in 2018*)

## Large Light and Power: (Rate 15, 16)\*

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Rates apply to non-residential services using more than 400 kW during the summer months, or more than 100,000 kWh per month.

- Customer Charge - \$275.00 per month
- Demand Charge
  - \$16.25 per kW secondary
  - \$15.71 per kW primary
- Facilities Charge
  - \$4.70 per kW secondary
  - \$4.30 per kW primary
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 2.85¢ per kWh secondary
  - 2.75¢ per kWh primary
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 2.44¢ per kWh secondary
  - 2.34¢ per kWh primary

## Large Power Contract: (Rate 44, 45)\*

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Rates apply to non-residential services using more than 4,000 kW per month.

- Customer Charge - \$550.00 per month
- Demand Charge
  - \$15.85 per kW secondary
  - \$15.15 per kW primary
- Facilities Charge
  - \$4.70 per kW secondary
  - \$4.50 per kW primary
- Energy Charge
  - Summer (June 1 - Sept. 30)**
  - 2.78¢ per kWh secondary
  - 2.65¢ per kWh primary
  - Winter (Oct. 1 - May 31)**
  - 2.30¢ per kWh secondary
  - 2.22¢ per kWh primary

# Proposed customer service fees for 2019

Effective Jan. 1, 2019

## New Service Fee

Applicable to every new account, move, transfer, etc., upon the request for service initiation (excluding accounts with a current Landlord Options form on file.) *(\$25 in 2018)* \$10

## Late Payment Fee

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Applicable to all accounts for amounts not paid by the due date on or after the first business day past the due date. 3.0 Percent of Past Due Amount

## Disconnect Charge for Nonpayment

Applicable to delinquent accounts.

Basic disconnection	\$65
Meter technician disconnection <i>(\$110 in 2018)</i>	\$125
LES crew disconnection <i>(\$190 in 2018)</i>	\$200

## Returned Payment Fee

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Applicable to accounts when a customer's payment is returned to LES from a financial institution. \$30

## Inaccessible Meter Fee

*No proposed changes for 2019.*

Applicable when an attempt by LES to read, service or access a meter is unsuccessful. \$75

## Mislabeled Meter Sockets or Cross-Wiring Fee

Applicable when LES is required to connect property-owner's mislabeled meters or cross-wired services. *(\$55 in 2018)* \$80/hour/employee

## Temporary Service Fee

Applicable when a temporary service and meter is required. *(\$150 in 2018)* \$175

## Meter Tampering Fee

*New for 2019.*

Applicable each time LES discovers a tampered, bypassed or otherwise misused meter. \$250
