He stated Discussion and that the Executive Search Committee responsible for the Recommendation recommendation weighed input from key LES external stakeholders, the mayor of Lincoln, LES employees, and the general public.

Each of the board members shared their observations and assessments of each of the candidates. While the board expressed appreciation and confidence in all of the candidates, there was a consensus of support for Emeka Anyanwu.

David Spinar moved approval of LES Resolution 2023-12 appointing Emeka Anyanwu to be the CEO of Lincoln Electric System subject to the subsequent approval of the appointment by the mayor by executive order and the City Council by resolution and the successful negotiations of employment terms and conditions between the LES Administrative Board and Emeka Anyanwu. 

LES RESOLUTION 2023- 12

WHEREAS, Lincoln Municipal Code, Section 4.24.010, requires the Lincoln Electric System (LES) Administrative Board to appoint a CEO, subject to approval by the Mayor by executive order and the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the LES Administrative Board selected the firm of Mycoff Fry Partners, LLC (Mycoff), a nationally known and recognized firm in employment recruiting for the electric industry, and appointed a search committee from among its members to work with the firm to solicit applications for the CEO position at LES; and

WHEREAS, an LES Search Committee comprised of the LES Board Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, a member of the Personnel and Organization Committee and two LES staff members worked with Mycoff to narrow the total pool of candidates to eight candidates who were interviewed by the LES Search Committee; and

WHEREAS, the LES Search Committee recommended a group of four finalists to be interviewed by the full LES Administrative Board; and

WHEREAS, the LES Administrative Board has interviewed the four finalists for the position on September 13-14, 2023, and has received and reviewed public input from candidate public meetings held for each of the four finalists;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the LES Administrative Board hereby appoints Emeka Anyanwu to be the CEO of Lincoln Electric System, subject to the subsequent approval of the appointment by the Mayor by executive order and the City Council by resolution and the successful negotiations of employment terms and conditions between the LES Administrative Board and Emeka Anyanwu.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LES Administrative Board hereby appoints the CEO Search Committee as the Board representatives to work with the Human Resources Manager to negotiate employment terms and conditions with Emeka Anyanwu and present an employment agreement to the Board for its review and approval.
