Holiday safety tips



Keep poisonous plants like mistletoe and holly berries out of the reach of your younger brothers, sisters and pets!



For a live tree, remind a grown-up to cut off about 2 inches of the trunk so it can soak up water when it needs a slurp. Remember to water it! If your tree isn't a live one, have your family check the label to make sure it says, "fire resistant."



Be sure your tree is at least 3 feet away from fireplaces and other things that make heat.



When you decorate, put breakable ornaments up high so your younger brothers and sisters can't grab them and get hurt.



Before you plug in or hang your lights, ask a grown-up to help you check to see if any parts are broken or loose or if there are frayed or bare wires! Follow the directions on the package so you know how many light sets can be plugged into one place. And, pick up LED lights this year to save energy!



Keep lit candles at least 12 inches away from anything that can burn, and don't forget to blow them out when you leave the room or before you go to sleep.
